Call to Order:

At 7:00 p.m. Chair Alicia Greco called the meeting to order with a salute to the flag

Public Comment

A. Greco reads to receive oral communications from members of the public. Members of the public may address the Select Board for up to 3 minutes; longer with the permission of the Chairperson. The Select Board shall not engage in discussion on topics raised during public comment but may choose to add the topic to a future agenda. This agenda segment will be limited to 15 minutes unless extended at the discretion of the Chairperson

Kathy Downey of 54 Main Street, Byfield spoke regarding to the town use of rodenticides, specifically second generation anti-coagulant rodenticides. She explains how the bait boxes function and where they are placed outside the Newbury Town Library grounds. She has formed a group called Save Newbury Wildlife to raise awareness and seek alternative. She is asking for two warrants: 1. Non-binding resolution. 2. Home Rule, which they have partnered with Mass Audubon Society to also restrict private land as well.

Nicole Bloor of 13 River Street, Newbury, spoke on researched alternatives to control the rodent population. Including trash management, use of newer technologies such as smart boxes that track where hotspots are, and the use of Contrapest.

Discussion: With approval from Chair, A. Greco, L. Matthews asked where the bait boxes have been found. Kathy Downey responded that there were four boxes located feet away from the children's story walk at the Town Library.

B. DiMaio with approval from Chair A. Greco asks for clarification because it would be banned use of SGARS on private property and will be brought up at Annual Town Meeting but the letter states that it's not available to households but only to contractors and licensed exterminators. Asks if they are going to propose that the Town or Board Of Health has to prohibit contractors from using.

D. Packer asks how this would be enforced and how would we control what people do?
