

The Newbury Recreation Committee, acting as agents for the Newbury Selectmen, set forth the following Rules and Regulations for the use of MANTER FIELDS throughout the year.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Each year, the Newbury Recreation Committee will prepare a calendar listing what sports organizations have use of what fields on what days and what times.
2. Each sports organization will have the opportunity to request field use. Requests will be received by the Recreation Committee by submission of a completed Field Use Application by March 31st. The Field Use Calendar will be created based on the information submitted on the Field Use Applications.
3. When the calendar is approved by a majority of the members of the Newbury Recreation Committee it will be considered adopted and binding.
4. All completed paper work and user fees must be furnished to the Committee prior to field use. A minimum of two contact people with cell phone numbers and e-mail addresses must be included in the paper work.
5. Inclement weather and/or poor field conditions may result in the cancellation of scheduled field use. That decision rests with the Newbury Recreation Committee and/or representatives approved by the Committee. The decision to close the fields will be considered binding.
6. There will be days, particularly during the summer, when the fields are not scheduled for use. If there is a request for field use not appearing on the calendar, approval will be required by a majority of the Committee to the dates requested. The Committee will base its decision on field condition and the impact of additional stress to the playing surface. Paper work and users fees will apply as usual.
7. Vaguely worded gatherings such as "captains practice" must adhere to the same requirements as other sports organizations with regard to adult supervision on the field during practice. The Committee also expects anyone involved in high school sports to adhere to all MIAA rules and regulations.
8. If there are overlapping requests for field use on any given day, preference will be given to organizations that service the greatest number of Newbury residents.
9. Precedence will not determine field use. Field use will be determined by the Newbury Recreation Committee.
10. The Committee reserves the right to alter or modify any of these Rules and Regulations for the best interest of the Town of Newbury.
11. Anyone who feels these Rules and Regulations are unreasonable or unfair, can contact the Newbury Selectmen.
