Town of Newbury Planning Board Public Hearing Notice

Residents of the Town of Newbury and other interested persons please note that on Wednesday, September 21, at 7:15 p.m., the Newbury Planning Board will hold an online virtual public hearing via Zoom to consider a Special Permit Modification Application to modify the Special Permit granted on May 16, 2018, by the Newbury Planning Board to Borrego Solar Systems, Inc., for a 2.795 mW Solar Energy Generating Facility on property located at 140R Main Street (formerly136 Main Street, 138 Main Street, 140 Main Street, and Off I-95). The Applicant, New Leaf Energy, is requesting modification of the original Special Permit to allow construction of a utility access road, including a bridge, in the location of an existing cart path on property located at 140R Main Street (Map R41, Lot 42) to provide maintenance access to the National Grid interconnection on the electric utility transmission corridor. The proposed work is as shown on the Plans entitled, "Notice of Intent and Special Permit Modification, 140R Main Street, Newbury MA 01922," prepared by Waterstone Engineering for New Leaf Energy, dated August 16, 2022, and described in supporting documents.
