I. Meeting Called: 6:13pm

III. Approval of Bill Schedule:

IV. New business:

Motion by Michael and seconded by Mark to suspend the order of the agenda to hear from Jean Ackerly and Christina Howe. The presentation was regarding the current Yoga program at the town library. At the present Christina Howe provides a structured program for older adults. Current funding is provides by the Friends of the Library and small donations. As this activity is more in line with the Mission of the Recreation Committee, it would be better served if there is a partnership among the Library, Council on Aging and the Recreation Committee to enhance the delivery of services. The recommendation is to host the weekly meeting at the Field House when appropriate as well as the library. Currently the yoga is offered monthly, where as a weekly session would provide greater benefits to the participants. The request is for \$60 per weekly session, through the year. The Committee is supportive of the idea and asked for additional information before moving forward. Working with the Council on Aging, is there sufficient interest to warrant weekly classes? What is the medium and mode of those attending? What will the days and time of the sessions be? Motion made by Michael and seconded by Mark to return the agenda.

V. Old Business:

Keys and Sensors: Clarified that the Newbury Police is responsible for opening the back gate on weekends. There continues to be concerns about the ability to remotely lock/lock the Field House. Further work needs to be done.
