Heavy Commercial Vehicle Exclusion

City/Town: **Newbury** Date: **June 17, 2025** Permit Number: **HCVE-205-7263**

Under the authority of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 85, Section 2, the Department of Transportation Highway Division (MassDOT) hereby approves the Traffic Rule and Regulation adopted by the Select Board of the Town of Newbury with such stipulations and exceptions, if any, as are noted herein.

This Heavy Commercial Vehicle Exclusion shall take effect when the Town of Newbury erects signage conforming to this Permit and MGL c. 85 § 2, upon the affected way(s).

Excluded Route(s): Larkin Road Exclusion Type: Two and one-half (2 ½) Tons Hours of Exclusion: 24 Hours per Day Days of Exclusion: 7 Days per Week Alternate Route(s): Central Street, Main Street, North Street (Town of Georgetown), Thurlow Street (Town of Georgetown), Jewett Street (Town of Georgetown), Jackman Street (Town of Georgetown); or Central Street, School Street, Elm Street, Jackman Street (Town of Georgetown)

This exclusion does not apply to heavy commercial vehicles going to or coming from any of the above excluded routes for the purpose of making deliveries of goods, materials, or merchandise to, or similar collections from, abutting land or buildings or adjacent streets or ways to which access cannot otherwise be gained; or to vehicles used in connection with the construction, maintenance and repair of said streets or public utilities herein; or to Federal, State, Municipal, or public service corporation owned vehicles.
